\*\*\*\*\* Christopher Brian Busch. Birmingham/Bloomfield, Michigan \*\*\*\*\*

1951: Born in Pontiac, Michigan

1951-60: Chris lived with his parents, (both deceased) in Rochester, New York, Short Hills, New Jersey and in Germany. Chris had 3 brothers, along with Chris, are deceased.

1960 thru High School: Chris attended a boarding school in Switzerland called Le Rosey. After Graduation, Chris stayed on there as an instructor for a while.

Late 60's/early 70's: Chris came back to the United States and attended Wayne State University for one year. This may be the time when Chris became involved in the "Big Brother" program.

1970's: Chris transferred to the Culinary Institute in Midland, Michigan, graduated and became a Chef. Chris then worked as a chef at a retirement community for a year. (Staying at the Sanford house near midland).

Mid 1970's: With the assistance of his father, he opens and runs the "Scotsman" restaurant in Alma, Michigan. Chris is living at . This is also the time he was taking kids from Flint to the Ess Lake cottage, the house in Sanford and an unidentified house in Alpena, Michigan.

1975-76: At this time, Chris is spending a lot of time with the young boys in Flint that are associated to his nephew . These boys are . Chris Busch then meets Greg Greene and begins a relationship with Greene, sharing their Pedophile practices and sharing children. Busch & Greene molest and threaten the kids. Busch is now carrying a handgun and shows the kids he's molesting. They discuss their fantasies of tying up and keeping children to molest. They talk about getting jobs that would allow one of them to always be with the child they abduct. Greene choked boys near death to keep them quiet.

Jan 1976: Chris Busch buys a 1975 blue, Chevrolet, Vega, 2dr, hatchback with white stripes.

Aug 1975 – Jan 1977: Beginning with several Detroit area kids are abducted, some molested and all killed, one of which was Mark Stebbins, abducted from Ferndale, February 15<sup>th</sup>, 1976. (Oakland County Child Killings)

Jan 25 1977: Greg Greene gets arrested by Flint PD for multiple CSC 1's (child under 13). Greene then tells the Flint Police that Chris Busch killed Mark Stebbins.

Jan 26, 1977: Chris gets arrested at the Scotsman restaurant in Alma on Flint's felony warrant. (See the Greene Time-Line, Jan 25<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> 1977, for details on the arrest of Busch & Greene, their possible connection to the child killings and how/when they were cleared. )

March 1977: Christopher Busch arrested on several other CSC warrants from other counties around the state, including Montmorency County, Midland County & Oakland County. Busch was

out on bond on all CSC charges. His father posted multiple \$9,000.00- \$10,000.00 bonds in different jurisdictions to get Chris out of jail. Chris had an upcoming court date for an exam in Oakland County of March 10<sup>th</sup>, 1977. We are unable to confirm whether or not Greg Greene was out on bond or not at the time of the King disappearance.

**March 16, 1977: Timothy King is abducted from Birmingham, Michigan. Several days later his dead body is found dumped in a ditch in Livonia, Michigan. He had been sexually molested and suffocated. Possible bind marks on his wrists and ankles, possibly from ropes.**

**April-May 1977:** Busch's family fires Keith Stark as Chris's attorney and hires Burgess & Burgess. Larry Burgess has his wife, Jane represent Chris Busch on his multiple CSC charges around the state. Jane Burgess brings Chris Busch to \_\_\_\_\_ for a private polygraph on his CSC charges. (This is when Busch possibly confessed or made admissions to \_\_\_\_\_ during a pre-polygraph interview. Busch told \_\_\_\_\_ about being polygraph by the State Police a few months earlier in regards to the Oakland County Child Killings, telling \_\_\_\_\_ Chris Busch's parents fly Jane Burgess around the state in a private plane to handle Chris's child molestation cases for him. \_\_\_\_\_ (Chris's mother) has a driver take her to Flint in a limousine she approaches one of the child victims on the street \_\_\_\_\_ and tries to pay him off to not cooperate with authorities against her son Chris.

**June 1977:** Greg Greene is convicted of Multiple CSC 1's and sent to prison for life.

\*\*\*\*\* The Killings stop \*\*\*\*\*

**June 77 – fall of 1978:** Chris Busch's multiple Child Molestation cases are being adjudicated at this time. The final disposition on all of his cases is probation. He did not get any jail time for any of the charges against him.

**November 1978:** Chris Busch is found dead in his home after committing suicide. Busch shot himself in the head with a rifle. Present at the suicide scene, along with the Bloomfield Twp, Police, \_\_\_\_\_ and the maid, \_\_\_\_\_ found pinned to the wall Busch was facing, was a penciled sketch of a young boy screaming, that looks a lot like Mark Stebbins. The boy in the sketch is wearing the same coat that the Stebbins boy was wearing. Also found in the room was a single shotgun shell on the desk along with ropes & ligatures lying in the middle of the floor in the walk-in closet.

\*\*\*\*\* Gregory Woodard Greene living in Flint, Michigan \*\*\*\*\*

**1965-66:** Greene was 15-16 years old. Social Security number issued to Greg Greene in Michigan.

**1968-69:** Greene living at \_\_\_\_\_ with his Father, 2 brothers and sister. Greene's mother died when he was 16. Father worked at GM.

**2-26-69:** Greene arrested for Burglary.

**5-25-69:** Greene arrested for Contributing to the Delinquency of a minor.

**1-2-70:** Greene arrested for Minor In Possession (MIP)

**1-2-70:** Greene was also charged with having police radio equipment in his vehicle.

\*\*\*\*\* 1970, Greene moved to California. He was 19-20 years old, \*\*\*\*\*

9-13-70: Greene arrested for Possession of Marijuana in Huntington Beach, Calif.

9-15-70: Greene was arrested for being present where narcotics are used/sold. Arrest made by Santa Ana Sheriff's Dept. in California.

9-4-72: Greene arrested for Conspiracy to commit Burglary, Forged Bills, Kidnapping, False Imprisonment & Receiving and Concealing Stolen Property. Huntington Beach, Calif.

2-1-73: Greene gets a traffic ticket for disobeying a stop sign. California

5-18-73: Greene gets another ticket for no valid license in possession.

8-2-74: Greene arrested in Huntington Beach, California for 45 counts of CSC 1 on young boys. He spends 6 months in the Orange County Jail. Greene choked 2 of his victims, 1 almost to death to keep him quiet, and then drove him to the hospital and dumped him off. The boy survived, that's how Greene got caught.

1-31-75: Greene sentenced to Patton State Mental Hospital in California as a mentally disturbed Sex Offender.

7-21-75: California Department of Justice record's show that Greene was discharged from the mental hospital on this date. Greene tells his Probation Officer and the Police in January of 1977, that he was released from the mental hospital 1-15-76. (This is the same day was abducted and killed).

July 1975: Busch told the Police during his interview in Flint in January of 1977, that he picked up a boy in Ferndale in the 9 Mile & Woodward area, approximately this time in 1975.

Fall 1975: told us during the interview that he thinks he remembers seeing Greg Greene around his neighborhood in Flint in the fall of 1975. aid that his family moved from Flint to Whitehall, Michigan in the late summer of 1976 and he knew Greene for almost year before they moved.

January 1976 told us that Busch bought the Vega in January from Al Serra Chevrolet. said 1977, but police reports indicate that Busch had this vehicle in 1976. Busch bought a blue, Chevrolet, Vega, 2dr, hatchback with white stripes.

2-14-76: Greene told the police and polygraph examiner t that he arrived back in Michigan from California on this date. Busch told and the police the same thing, stating that he arrived back in Michigan from England 2-14-76. Busch told that he flew into Detroit Metro on this date. Busch told the police two hours earlier that he flew into Flint Bishop Airport and his parents picked him up and drove him home to Birmingham. He told that after a day or two, he went to Sanford & Hillman, Michigan. \*\*\* The papers reported Stebbins abducted on 2-13-76. Stebbins was actually not abducted until 2-15-76. \*\*\*

2-15-76: Mark Stebbins abducted from the 9 Mile & Woodward area in Ferndale. He was wearing a blue parka with fur around the edge of the hood.

2-19-76: Mark Stebbins found dead at 10 Mile Rd. & Greenfield in Southfield. Mark had been anally molested, struck over the head and strangled. He had possible binds marks on his wrists & ankles.

5-15-76: Greene "said" he got a job on the midnight shift at K-Mart on Belsay Rd. in Flint. (Custodian)

5-29-76: Busch & Greene tool to a rural area, off Dixie Hwy. in the Groveland Twp. area of Oakland County. They were driving in Busch's blue Chevy, 2dr, hatchback with a white stripe. Greene had told prior to this that Busch had killed a boy in the past.

thought that Greene & Busch were going to molest and kill him today. had a handgun with him in the vehicle.

stated that Busch

**May 1976:** Greene tells the police that he is seeing a counselor named Ron Matthews, at the Genesee County Mental health Department, as part of his probation from California Department of Corrections.

**June 1976:** Greene bought a motorcycle (125 Yamaha) from Dealership in Flushing and financed it thru Citizens Bank in Flint.

**July 1976:** Greene meets (Victim) thru Little League in Flint and molests him 5-10 times thru November of 1976 told police that Greene told him that he has molested over 100 kids. told police, that Greene would anally molest him.

**Aug - Sept. 1976:** Greene tells police, that he purchased his brown, 1974, Chevrolet van from Al Serra Chevrolet in Flint and that he financed it thru Citizens Bank. Mi. lic. Plate #

**Aug 7<sup>th</sup>, 1976:** was abducted while hitchhiking on I-75. She was found dead in the Miamisburg River in Ohio on 8-11-76. The cause of death was Carbon Monoxide poisoning. A witness in Miamisburg, had seen 2 white male subjects in there twenties along the side of the river, pulling something with a rope, the evening before. The witness stated a third person was lying on the ground. This witness described the vehicle they were near was an older van, no windows, grey or cream colored, parked along the banks of the river. The police later confirmed that there had been a vehicle parked on the grass where the witness stated she had observed this van.

**12-22-76:** Jill Robinson was abducted today from the 13 Mile & Woodward area of Royal Oak.

**12-26-76:** Jill Robinson was found dead today, along the shoulder of I-75 just north of the 16 Mile on ramp. Robinson had been shot in the face with a shotgun. It was possible she had been suffocated, but due to the extent of the injuries from the shotgun blast, the M.E. was unable to make that determination. It did not appear as if she had been molested or bound.

**1-2-1977:** Kristine Mihelich was abducted today, from the area of the "7-11" store at 12 Mile & Oakshire in Berkley, across the street from Hartfield's Bowling Alley where her mother worked.

**January 1977:** The police use the media to put out information about Mihelich's disappearance. They put her description and photos of her on the television news and in the newspapers, and talked about Mihelich's and the other cases on the radio.

**1-21-77:** Kristine Mihelich found dead on Bruce Lane in the 13 Mile & Telegraph area. It did not appear that she had been molested or bound. The cause of death was suffocation.

**1-25-77:** Greene arrested today by Flint PD for 3 counts of CSC 1<sup>st</sup> Degree. He tells the police that Chris Busch killed Mark Stebbins. OCK Task Force notified of this development by Flint PD. Lt. Simmons & Detective Doan from Southfield PD travel to Flint PD to interview Greene about this statement.

**1-25-77:** Greene is interviewed by Doan & Simmons at Flint PD. Doan writes a very brief report on this interview. Doan stated that Greene gave them all the information he could on Chris Busch. Doan wrote that they went into the background on Greene and believed he (Greene) was as good a suspect as Busch. Doan wrote about Greene's 50 counts of CSC 1 on boys in California and Greene choking a boy near death. The only other thing about Busch in this interview report with Greene was the following: Greene states Busch has a cabin up near West Branch where he take these young boys. Greene stated he might have directions on how to get to the cabin.

**1-26-1977:** \_\_\_\_\_s interviewed at Flint PD by Doan, Cattel (Ferndale PD) & Sgt. Miller (Flint PD). During this interview, \_\_\_\_\_ old Detectives that he met Greg Greene in May of 1976, stating that Greene introduced him \_\_\_\_\_ to Chris Busch \_\_\_\_\_ talked about Busch & Greene molesting him in the past \_\_\_\_\_ told Detectives about Greene strangling him unconscious before when he \_\_\_\_\_ would not do what he (Greene) wanted. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that Greene has told him in the past that Chris Busch has killed a boy. \_\_\_\_\_ also stated that Greene asked him to go to a "Play-land" store and help him kidnap and kill a young boy. Greene promised \_\_\_\_\_ that, if he helped him, he would cut off the boy's penis, put it in a box for him. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that this never happened. \_\_\_\_\_ went on to say that Greene would forcefully sodomize him even though he \_\_\_\_\_ would cry and beg him to stop, Greene wouldn't. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that Greene never tied him up, but stated that he knows of other boys he did tie-up.

**1-26-77: Detectives searched through Greene's van at the impound yard in Flint.** Detectives were looking for the directions to Busch's cabin near West Branch and found two Polaroid's of child victims from the Flint case against Greene and also two pairs of "child's panties." This report does not say if any directions were found.

**1-28-77: Arrest of Christopher Busch at the "Scotsman" restaurant in Alma, Mi. on Flint's felony warrant.**

**1-28-77: Detectives conduct a consent search of Busch's home in Alma, located @ \_\_\_\_\_**  
During this search, Detectives find 2 shotguns (16 gauge & 20 gauge), ½ Lb. - 1 Lb. Of Marijuana, 1 suitcase containing misc. ropes and ligatures and 1 suitcase containing child porn, books, magazines & films. (This was all confiscated as part of the Flint child molestation case against Busch).

**1-28-77: Christopher Busch is then interviewed at Flint PD.** During this interview, Busch admits sexual involvement with \_\_\_\_\_ w/m 15 yrs. And also admits involvement with Greg Greene. Busch admits being a Pedophile and liking young boys. He "lays out" the following 3 locations that he has picked up young boys in the past: 9 Mile & Woodward in Ferndale, Royal Oak near 13 Mile & Woodward, and the 12 Mile & Greenfield area, specifically Hartfields Bowling Alley & the "7-11" store across the street. **\*\*\* These are our first three abduction sites in chronological order of the abductions.\*\*\*** Busch went on to say that he and Greene have discussed their sexual fantasies about kidnapping a young boy, tying him up and sexually abusing him. Busch went on to say that he and Greene agreed that one would get a job during the day and the other at night so that one of them would always be with the boy. Busch denied any involvement in the Stebbins case. Busch tells Detectives that he flew from London to New York to Chicago and then into Bristol Airport in Flint on February 14<sup>th</sup> 1976. (The day before the Stebbins abduction). **Busch agreed to take a polygraph in the OCCK case, against the wishes of his attorney.**

**1-28-77: 8:00pm, Chris Busch was polygraphed by MSP examiner \_\_\_\_\_ Deputy**  
Oakland County Prosecutor Dick Thompson was flown from Oakland County to the Flint post for the polygraph. Busch was asked 6 relevant questions by Cabot in regards to the Stebbins case. It was Cabot's opinion that Busch when denying involvement in the Stebbins case

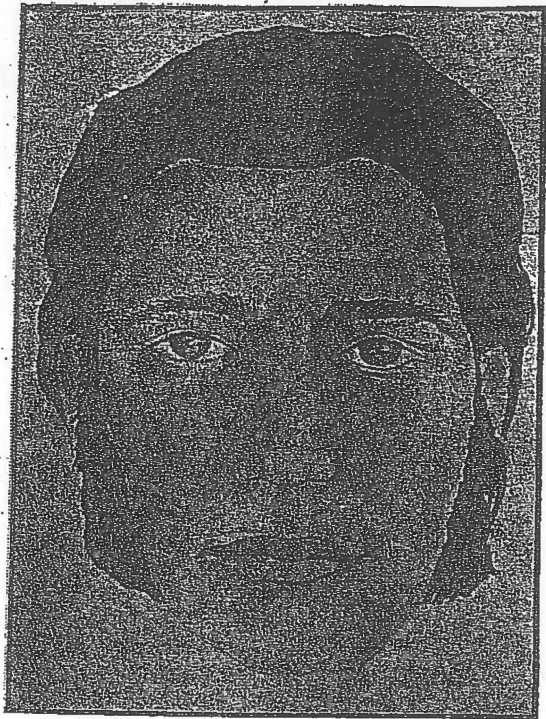

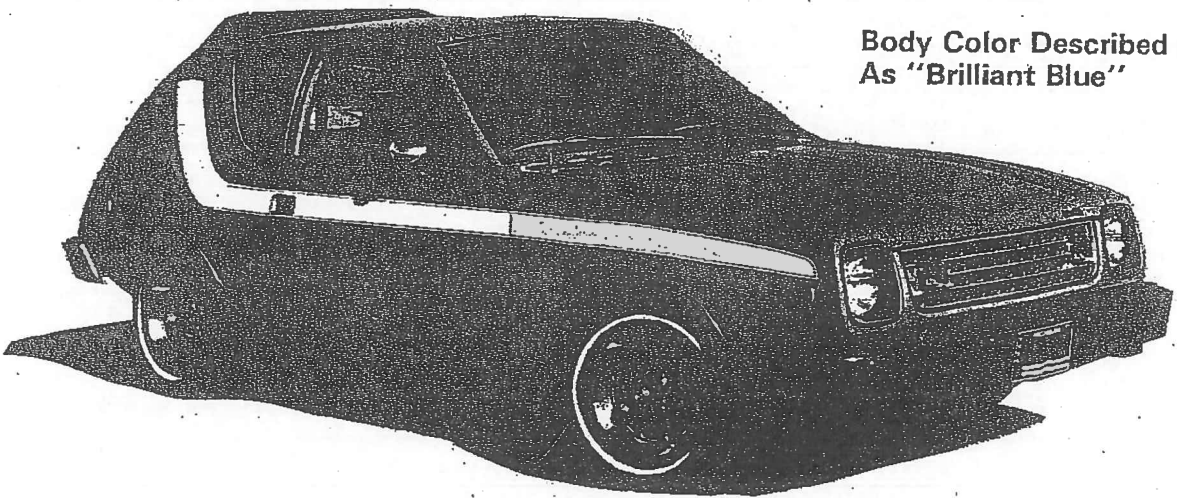

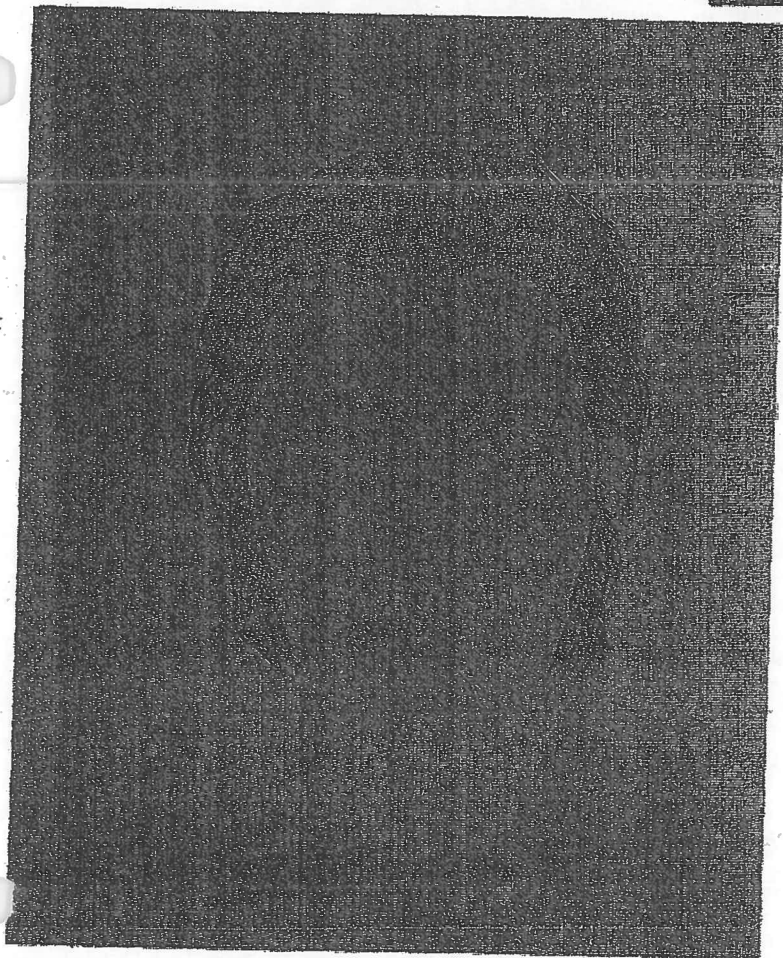

Michigan Public Act 343 of 1925, as amended, requires that the attending physician, or in the absence of an attending physician, a medical examiner shall fill out and sign the medical certificate of death within 24 hours after death.

The funeral director is responsible for completing all other portions of the certificate and obtaining a burial or removal permit prior to disposing of the body or removing from the registration district where the death occurred.

Many important legal, personal, public health and social welfare interests require complete and accurate registration of all deaths. Individuals need certification of the facts of death for insurance claims, liquidation of estates, to prove name of spouse and parents and other general legal use. Social and health agencies need information on the causes of death for purposes of planning health programs; they need information on the number of births and deaths in making population estimates; and they need birth and death statistics to measure the fertility and mortality of various racial, economic or social groups.
