after numerous attempts to talk, the undersigned was finally able to meet [redacted] & her mother at their home today, [redacted]

The undersigned advised [redacted] that the reason they were being contacted was the result of concern expressed by [redacted] sister, [redacted]

[redacted] is a clerk at 30 White Cleaver on Tele in Elm Twp. In early February she contacted the undersigned who was picking up cleaning at the time & asked if I was familiar with Dick Mar. when I responded that I was she related that her little sister had a problem of some sort & had told her about it. I asked [redacted] to pursue the matter & asked that I be able to meet her. A few days later, [redacted] was contacted again. She related that her sister did not want to pursue the matter or didn't want to talk about it. Since [redacted]

[redacted] never gave her sister name, it wasn't until much later in a conversation with [redacted] that it became apparent that the sister was [redacted] sixty was [redacted]

from March 9 until March 23,

the undersigned made numerous attempts to get an appt - [redacted] her parents. No one was home (it was later learned that the [redacted] were in Florida) and they times to meet couldn't be coordinated. A meeting for 3-26 was finally agreed upon.

Initially, [redacted] and her mother were quite nervous + [redacted] repeatedly denied any manner of improper actions on the part of M.N. It became apparent that mother + daughter were not on good terms + that this was going to be counterproductive. [redacted] exercised herself at my request [redacted] while continuing to deny any impropriety, became increasingly nervous. After some time had passed + she had relaxed considerably, she related that, in fact, over the last few years, there had been numerous occasions when she met Off M.N. on the street. She related that they were good friends but often she was not sure where he was coming from. She related that on 3-5 occasions Off M.N. took or grabbed her hand in his + pulled it into the patrol car + tried to place it on his body. When asked if he ever succeeded [redacted] said no. When asked what area of his body she felt he interded her to touch, she said the lower abdomen. When asked if she feared he was going to put it between her legs she responded that she feared that

Both were strongly urged to keep all of this information confidential due to the seriousness of ~~the~~ it & were advised that I would be in ~~the~~ contact with them in the near future.

No written or recorded statement was requested of [REDACTED] at that time.

Recommended Procedure - Investigation of Village Officer.

- As a result of a citizen complaint [redacted] immediate supervisor (M'Keo) assigned to investigate to see if complaint can be substantiated.
- M'Keo substantiates [redacted] complaint but also is made aware of similar incidents by the same officer in the past.
- Preliminary investigation of other complaints suggests that they can be substantiated. Supervisor (M'Keo) recommends that a complete internal investigation commence (all leads pursued, statements taken from any victims or witnesses).
- Internal investigation conducted by independent member of dept staff.
- Consideration given to suspension pending the outcome of the internal investigation.

Off. Keene advised that he was
not familiar with the [redacted]
family but that he did have some
information about similar suspicious
incidents:

1. Off Keene advised that he was familiar
with a relationship that Off. McNamee
had with a girl by the name of
[redacted]

He had observed McNamee at the girl's
house and in front of her house on
numerous occasions. On one occasion
he & Off. Lebonenau observed when they
were run was [redacted] & McNamee in
McNamee's personal car. Keene & Lebonenau
stated that Lebonenau saw the girl's head on
McNamee's shoulder. Their intention
was to relate the info to the Police
Commissioners at the time & show him
the two, but McNamee left before they
were able to arrange this.

2 Off Keeney relates that he was advised by a girl by the name of [redacted] that on one occasion, while he was in McNamee, he asked her if she ever saw the place where the bear bit him and then took her hand & put it on his crotch area
